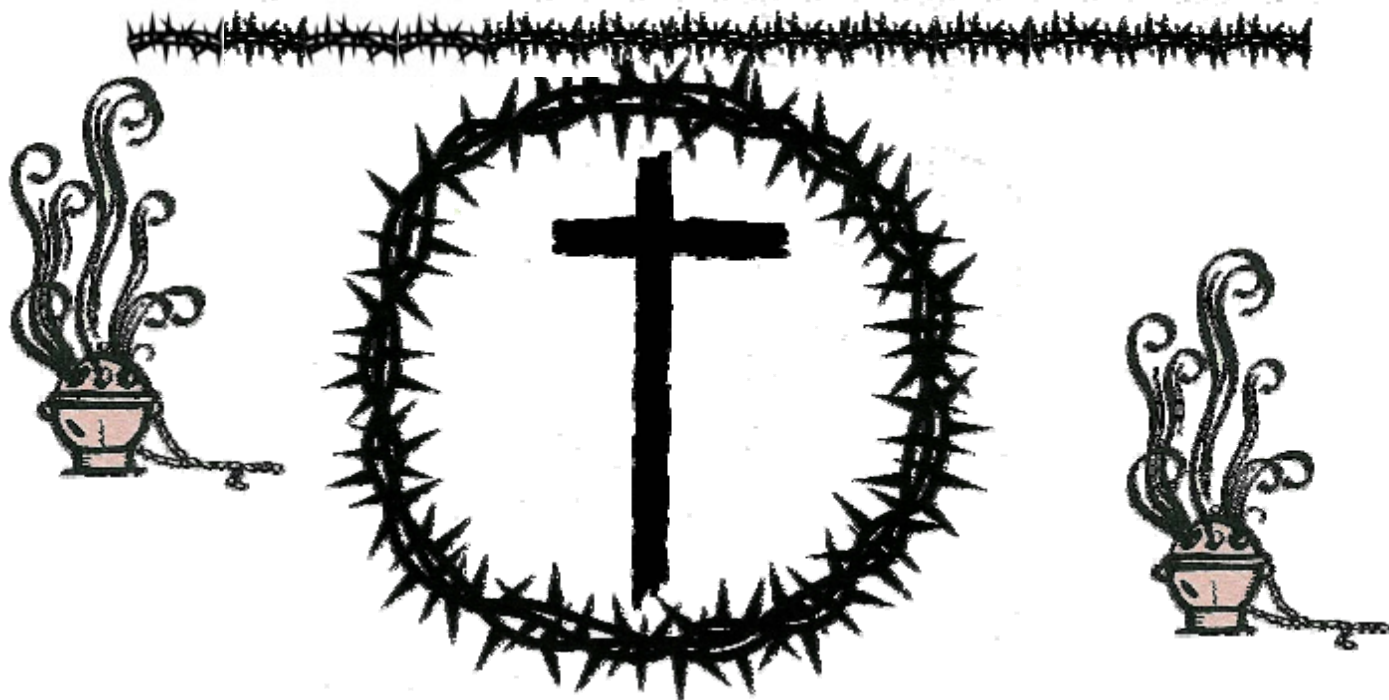

# *Ash Wednesday*

*Remember man that thou art dust and unto dust thou shalt return*



Who shall accuse against the elect of God? God that justifieth.

Who is he that shall condemn? Christ Jesus that died, yea that is risen also again; who is at the Right Hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

Who then shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation? or distress? or famine? or nakedness? or danger? or persecution? or the sword?

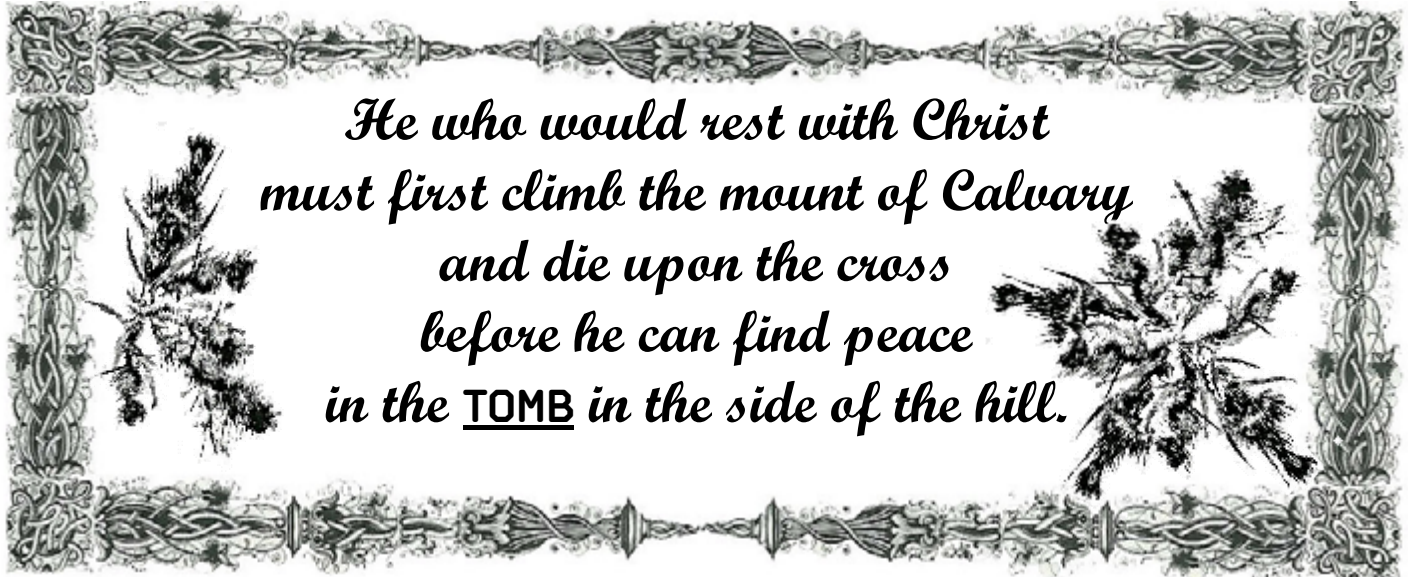
As it is written: For Thy sake we are put to death all the day long. We are counted as sheep for the slaughter.

But in all these things we overcome, because of Him that hath loved us.

For I am sure that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor might,

nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans Chapter 8)

1. There will be Catechism class today after the 10:00 AM Mass.
2. **Be reminded of the Lenten Stations of the Cross and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament every Friday night of Lent at 7:00 PM.** Those who, because of distance, cannot attend this ceremony are urged to follow through with it, every Friday night in their own homes and in the presence of their HOME CHAPELS. Also it would be laudable for the Stations to be prayed more often during Lent.
3. Please pray for all the Sick and Shut-ins of our Chapels. **LET US ALSO PRAY FOR EVERYONE.** Let us pray for ALL the priests and religious men and women of the world.. **Do not forget and continue praying for the dead and wounded and dispossessed people of Haiti.**
4. **Happy MARDI GRAS to one and all. Enjoy the day but it is ALL OVER at 12:00 midnight!**



5. **ASH-WEDNESDAY IS A DAY OF SOLEMN FAST FOR ALL FROM AGES 21 TO 59 AND ABSTINENCE FOR ALL THOSE AGES 7 AND UP.** All are bound by this Law of Fast and Abstinence – unless their health or the nature of their work prevents them.
6. **ASH WEDNESDAY. MASSES IN THE ABBEY CHURCH WILL BE AT 6:00 AM, 8:00 AM, AND 7:00 PM, WITH DISTRIBUTION OF ASHES AFTER EACH MASS.** It is NOT A Holyday of Obligation, ASH WEDNESDAY IS A NO-NONSENSE DAY. It is a time to reflect and to do penance.
7. **Beginning with Ash Wednesday**, please do not neglect the daily Lenten Readings.
8. Today, Saint Blaise blessing of throats after Mass at Saint Pius V Chapel, Birmingham.
