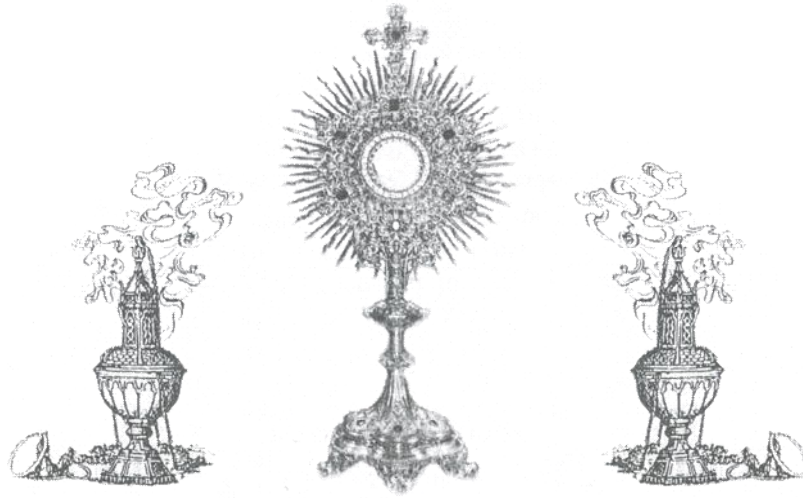

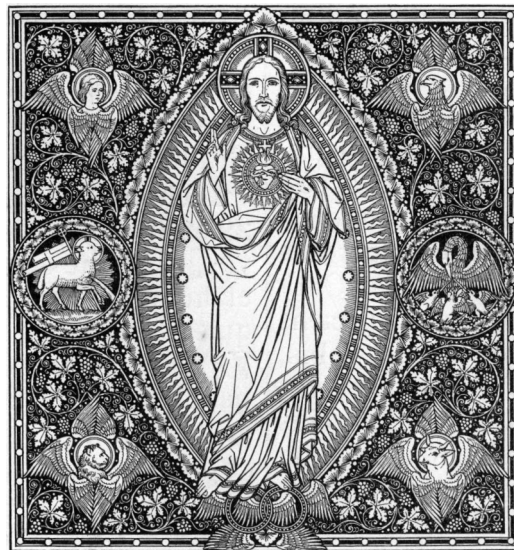

After Mass is completed the Procession with the Blessed Sacrament begins.

After the procession has re-entered the Church and the Blessed Sacrament has reached the Communion Rail, the procession stops; after the people have all returned to their places, everyone kneels and sings:

**Jesus, My Lord, My God, My All**

Jesus, my Lord, my God, my All  
How can I love Thee as I ought?  
And how revere this wondrous gift,  
So far surpassing hope or thought?

Had I but Mary's sinless heart  
To love Thee with, my dearest King;  
Oh! with what bursts of fervent praise,  
Thy goodness, Jesus, would I sing.

Oh! see upon the altar placed  
The Victim of divinest love!  
Let all the earth below adore,  
and join the choirs of heav'n above.

*(Chorus)*

Sweet Sacrament, we Thee adore  
Oh! make us love Thee more and more;  
Oh! make us love Thee more and more.

*When the Hymn "Jesus, My Lord," is finished, the procession proceeds to the High Altar and the Blessed Sacrament is placed upon the Altar and the **Act of Reparation** is recited by all.*

**Act of Reparation to the Sacred Heart of Jesus**

O sweet Jesus, \* Whose overflowing charity for men \* is requited by so much forgetfulness, negligence and contempt, \* behold us prostrate before Thy altar \* eager to repair by a special act of homage \* the cruel indifference and injuries, \* to which Thy loving Heart is everywhere subject. \* Mindful alas! that we ourselves have had a share in such great indignities, \* which we now deplore from the depths of our hearts, \* we humbly ask thy pardon \* and declare our readiness to atone by voluntary expiation \* not only for our own personal offences, \* but also for the sins of those, \* who, staying far from the path of salvation, \* refuse in their obstinate infidelity to follow Thee, \* their Shepherd and Leader, \* or, renouncing the vows of their baptism, \* have cast off the sweet yoke of Thy law. \* We are now resolved to expiate each and every deplorable outrage committed against Thee; \* we are determined to make amends \* for the manifold offences against Christian modesty \* in unbecoming dress and behavior, \* for all the foul seductions laid to ensnare the feet of the innocent, \* for the frequent violation of Sundays and holydays, \* and the shocking blasphemies uttered against Thee and Thy Saints. \* We wish also to make amends for the insults \* to which Thy Vicar on earth and Thy priests are subjected, \* for the profanation, by conscious neglect or terrible acts of sacrilege, \* of the very Sacrament of Thy divine love; \* and lastly for the public crimes of nations \* who resist the rights and the teaching authority of the Church \* which Thou hast founded. \* Would, O divine Jesus, \* we were able to wash away such abominations with our blood. \* We now offer, in reparation for these violations of Thy divine honor, \* the satisfaction Thou didst once make to Thy eternal Father on the cross \* and which Thou dost continue to renew daily on our altars; \* we offer it in union with the acts of atonement of Thy Virgin Mother \* and all the Saints \* and of the pious faithful on earth; \* and we sincerely promise to make reparation, \* as far as we can with the help of Thy grace, \* for all neglect of Thy great love \* and for the sins we and others have committed in the past. \* Henceforth we will live a life of unwavering faith, \* of purity of conduct, \* of perfect observance of the precepts of the gospel \* and especially that of charity. \* We promise to the best of our power \* to prevent others from offending Thee \* and to bring as many as possible to follow Thee. \* O loving Jesus, \* through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary \* our model in reparation, \* deign to receive the voluntary offering we make of this act of expiation; \* and by the crowning gift of perseverance \* keep us faithful unto death in our duty \* and the allegiance we owe to Thee, \* so that we may all one day come to that happy home, \* where Thou with the Father and the Holy Ghost livest and reignest, God, \* world without end. \* Amen.
